


# EVENT FLOORPLAN

Accounting Professor and Author, "Fool Me Once: Scams, Stories, and Secrets from the Trillion-Dollar Fraud Industry"

Dr. Kelly Richmond Pope is the Dr. Barry Jay Epstein Endowed Professor of Forensic Accounting at DePaul University in Chicago, IL. Pope is a nationally recognized expert in risk, forensic accounting, and white-collar crime research, and an award-winning educator, researcher, author, and awardwinning documentary filmmaker. Pope teaches managerial and forensic accounting both at the undergraduate and graduate level. Her book Fool Me Once: Stories and Lessons Inside the Trillion Dollar Fraud Industry published by Harvard Business Review Press (2023) is a riveting look at the perpetrators, victims, and whistleblowers behind financial crimes. Pope is also the author of Managerial Accounting, 1st edition published by Pearson Learning (2022).

Pope currently serves on the board of directors for the Greater Chicago Food Depository (GCFD) and chairs its audit committee. Pope is a former director and finance committee chair for Mercy Hospital & Medical Center, former director of the Illinois CPA Society, and former member of the governing council for American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA).

In 2020, the AICPA and the CPA Practice Advisor named Dr. Pope among the top 25 most powerful women in accounting. Her area of expertise lies in understanding and identifying financial fraud risk within financial statements, assessing corporate culture and compliance systems designed to confront internal control challenges. Pope's research on executive misconduct culminated in directing and producing the award-winning documentary, All the Queen's Horses which explores the largest municipal fraud in U.S. history. Pope's TED Talk entitled "How Whistle-blowers Shape History" has been viewed over 1.6 million times, translated into 20 languages, and serves as a resource to help organizations and individuals embrace internal whistleblowing.

Pope is a frequent international speaker to numerous corporations, nonprofits, and government agencies. Pope has appeared on news outlets such as CNBC, the BBC, and WGN-TV offering commentary on fraud, risk, and ethics. Additionally, Pope has appeared in publications such as Bloomberg, The Wall Street Journal, CFO Drive, Accounting Today, Forbes, The Washington Post, and The Daily Beast discussing fraud and the need for sound internal controls. Pope has earned her Bachelor of Science in accounting from North Carolina A&T State University and her master's in accountancy and doctorate in accounting from Virginia Tech. Pope resides in the Chicagoland area.

OUR PROGRAMS





In 2007, NABA launched the CPA Bound program to address barriers black professionals and students face in obtaining their Certified Public Accountants ("CPA") license. Phase two of the program launched in 2020, with the goal of creating and equipping a community of CPA candidates with the tools and resources needed for licensure achievement.

As a community, NABA's intent is to support in relieving some of the stresses NABA members experience in their journey toward CPA attainment. NABA strives to promote unity; an encouraging environment, uplifting engagement that breaks through the barriers of isolation, during and after the CPA achievement process, thereby, "lifting as we climb."

#### The program will focus on the following CPAs for success:

- **1. Connect:** Create a community of candidates seeking to address the pain points of studying for the CPA exam through group communication.
- **2. Prepare:** Prepare CPA candidates by providing access to CPA requirement information, study materials and scholarship opportunities.
- **3. Award:** Celebrate new CPAs with recognition awards and incentive opportunities.
- **4. Support:** Support current CPAs in maintaining their license by promoting CPE opportunities and leveraging relationships with NASBA and the AICPA.

#### **Program components will include:**

- Community chats and discussion boards, connecting candidates across the country preparing for exams
- · Bi-monthly webinars featuring:
  - o CPA exam review partners
  - o CPA study coaches
  - o Inspirational speakers





## ACAP is a unique pipeline from high school to college that allows students to become prepared and informed about the expectations of college life.

The Accounting Career Awareness Program and the Accelerated Career Awareness Program (ACAP) for high school students (freshmen through seniors) in which they are put in the NABA pipeline to help build future Black Business Leaders with a focus on directing them to major in accounting, finance, and its related business fields including entrepreneurship. It included a one-week residency at a college or university combined with year-round programming.

During a week-long summer campus residency program, a select group of students can explore careers in accounting, finance, and business-related fields via a rigorous class and study schedule, college-level content, and valuable networking opportunities. ACAP® introduces underrepresented diverse high school students to accounting, finance, economics, technology, and management while providing the foundation of financial literacy and the development of interpersonal skills. Prominent business leaders share their knowledge, provide tips for success, and discuss career opportunities. Student's experience careers in accounting firsthand through tours of local certified public accounting firms and companies in the private sector. Students to learn the value of collaboration and teamwork through the group projects or case study initiatives. The program concludes with a recognition luncheon or banquet for students, parents, speakers, and corporate partners.

Through mentoring we help them to matriculate to college but also how to succeed in college through a mentoring initiative. The program is fully supervised and all-expenses-paid. Students selected will receive free tuition, room, and board, books, materials, tools, NABA HS membership, and mentoring.

Since its beginning in 1980, the program has served as a turning point in the academic lives of thousands of high school students, motivating them to pursue higher education and develop their own unique paving and pathing to reach their maximum potential.
